In ordert to make best use of this instrument, a number of formal regulations must be observed in practice. Only the presentation of conforming documents offers the full protection of the letter of credit as a security instrument.

This seminar makes it easier for participants to issue documents in a formally correct manner in compliance with the uniform Customs and Practice for Documentary Credits, UPC/ERA 600, and to assess the feasibility of letter of credit texts.
